COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE (CAC) MEMBER RECRUITMENT INFORMATION

Sonoma Clean Power (SCP) is the default electricity provider for Sonoma and Mendocino counties, providing clean energy at competitive rates and promoting local solutions to climate change. SCP has been serving Sonoma County customers since May 2014, and began serving Mendocino County in June 2017. SCP is a not-for-profit public agency, independently run by the participating cities of Cloverdale, Cotati, Fort Bragg, Petaluma, Point Arena, Rohnert Park, Santa Rosa, Sebastopol, Sonoma, Willits, Windsor, and the counties of Sonoma and Mendocino. SCP is governed by our Board of Directors ("Board") which consists of local elected representatives from the participating counties and cities. The Community Advisory Committee, or CAC, is charged with reviewing SCP's programs, budget and rates, and advising the Board on planning and business issues. The CAC is comprised of between 7 and 11 volunteers, appointed by the SCP Board. The committee meets 6 to 10 times per year and terms last for 4-years.

November 1, 2019	EXTENDED deadline for accepting applications. Applications will be reviewed by an ad hoc committee of the Board.
October-November 2019	The Ad Hoc Committee appointed by our Board will hold interviews with potential candidates.
December 5, 2019	Board of Directors votes to approve recommended committee members.
January 2020	Introduction and swearing in of new CAC members at Board meeting.
