The concerns of our communities and society have changed dramatically with the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, seasonal wildfires, and disparities in social justice and racial equity. SCP's Community Giving Budget will be allocated as follows for the 2021-22 fiscal year:

- 50% to efforts advancing social justice and racial equity within marginalized communities.
- 25% to efforts supporting local small businesses and workers affected by COVID-19.
- 25% to efforts supporting fire relief and fire mitigation.
