Sonoma Clean Power is proud to serve our communities by delivering on our Mission of turning the tide on the climate crisis, through bold ideas and practical programs. This includes positively impacting the greatest needs of our communities through making meaningful contributions.

As the needs of our communities and society have changed dramatically with the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, seasonal wildfires and the need for social justice and racial equity and justice, SCP's modest Community Outreach budget will be allocated as follows for the 2020-21 fiscal year:

- 50% to nonprofit organizations advancing social justice, in particular racial equity and justice, within marginalized communities
- 25% to groups supporting local small businesses and workers affected by COVID-19
- 25% for local non-profit groups supporting fire relief

Requesting Support from SCP

Interested nonprofit, community and business groups can submit requests for support by completing a Request for SCP Community Support form.

We will evaluate each request carefully against available budget, our targeted areas of focus, program guidelines and goals, and will respond to requests in a timely manner.

These guidelines will be evaluated annually and are subject to change, to ensure consistent alignment with the Agency's Mission and goals.
